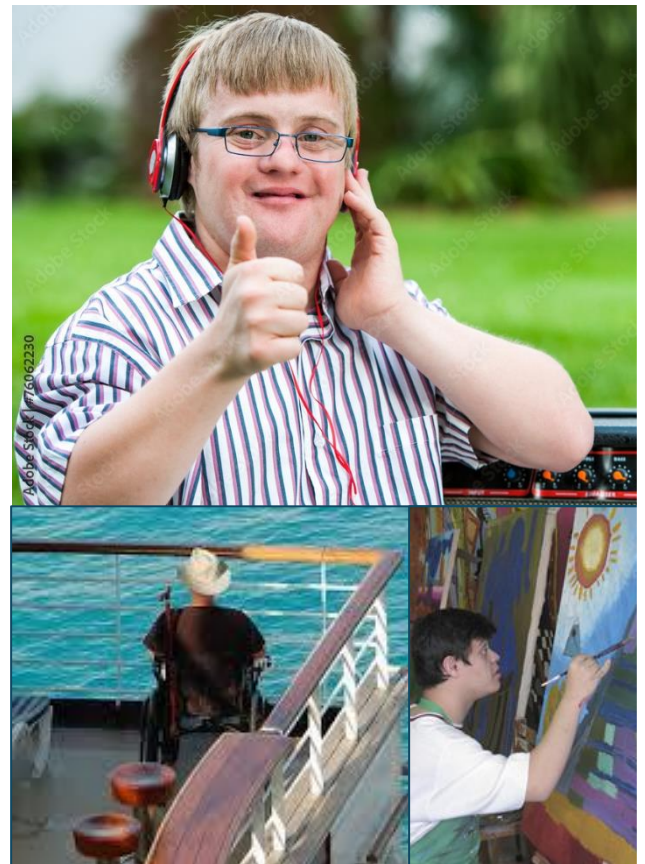

- The main campus is on Ferncreek and Michigan in South Orlando.
- Five group homes are located throughout Central Florida.



- **RESIDENTIAL SERVICES**

- Safe, clean, cheerful, & home-like atmosphere!
- Training and assistance with personal hygiene and grooming, cooking, nutrition, household chores, simple budgeting, shopping, safety in the community and home, socialization, and all other aspects of daily living.
- Private or shared rooms
- Transportation for group activities and shopping
- Weekend Sporting Events, Theme Park Trips, Cruises, Concerts, Family Parties, plus additional various choice activities.
- Specific and varied levels of supervision as appropriate
- Medical needs assistance to include medication management and routine medical appointments.
- Group participation at home and within the community.
- Participants of the PCI Residential Program may also have a community-based job, volunteer, or attend an ADT program.

- **ADULT DAY TRAINING**

- Adult Day Training is offered Monday – Friday. PCI seeks clients interested in accessing services for all 5 days.
- Various levels of care - 1:3, 1:5, 1:10 staff to participant ratio.
- Train and compete with our *Special Olympics* Teams
- Community Oriented Outreach Program that provides choices of meaningful, varied person-centered training in self-help, socialization, recreational and adaptive skills.
- Behavioral Services – Positive Intervention Program
- Therapeutic Activity Program with Sensory Stimulation Room
- Community outings and volunteer activities on a weekly basis
- Transition into Supported Employment through optional community opportunities.
- Monthly parties with an in-house DJ
- Music & Dance Therapy
- Professional Story Tellers expand imagination and problem solving.

- **EMPLOYMENT SERVICES**

- Services designed to assist people in choosing, obtaining and maintaining employment that meets each client's career ambitions.

- **TRANSPORTATION**

- Connectivity to and from the ADT main campus, group homes and/or personal homes.
